4.1 Can I use this to share my block list with others?

No, Multiblock requires read/write access to each account it's linked to and syncs bidirectionally. That means their changes propagate to your account and your changes propagate back to them. In Multiblock every account is equal in authority.

Options

--version

Show the version and exit.

-v, --verbose

Verbose output, can be used multiple times to increase logging level

accounts

Manage Mastodon accounts

```
exhibit accounts [OPTIONS] COMMAND [ARGS]...
```

add

Add a new account

```
exhibit accounts add [OPTIONS] USER
```

Arguments

USER

Required argument

list

List accounts

```
exhibit accounts list [OPTIONS]
```

remove

remove an existing account

```
exhibit accounts remove [OPTIONS] USER
```

Arguments

USER

Required argument

sync

Sync accounts

```
exhibit sync [OPTIONS]
```

--blocks, --no-blocks

Sync block lists between accounts

--mutes, --no-mutes
